	, with support from, moves to adopt the following resolution:							
<u>Resolution</u>								
Whereas,	the City and Independence Township have appointed a joint District Library Agreement Committee to draft an agreement under which the Independence Township Library would become a district library established by the city and township, governed by a separate and independent library board funded by a separate district library millage;							
Whereas,	the Township and City have approved the formation of a district library and the library board will seek approval of a district library millage on the August 5, 2014 ballot;							
Whereas,	the library is currently funded by a .691 mill levy on property in the Township and by payments form the City to the library as described in the District Library Agreement;							
Whereas,	the City's payments to the library under the District Library Agreement are equal to an annual amount determined by the formula of multiplying the number of mills assessed in the Township for library services times the taxable value of property assessed in the city for property taxation purposes;							
Whereas,	the City makes its payments to the library under the District Library Agreement from the City's general fund and, unlike the Township, the City does not impost a separate library millage;							
Whereas,	if the voters approved a district library millage, the district library will receive funding from its separate library millage beginning with the December 2014 tax levy; the Township will no longer impose its library millage beginning with the December 2014 tax bill; and the District Library Agreement will provide for the termination of the City's payment obligations under the District Library Agreement as of December 31, 2014; and							
Whereas,	in order for the city property owners to be placed on an equal footing with the Township property owners with respect to funding the library, if the voters approve the district library millage, it would be appropriate for the City to reduce its general fund operating millage levy to the same extent that the Township eliminates its separate library millage;							

NOW	THER	FFORF	RF IT	RESOL!	VFD:

- 1. It is the intention of the City Council of the City of the Village of Clarkston to place City property owners on an equal footing with Township property owners with respect to funding the library.
- 2. If the voters approve a district library millage at the August 5, 2014 election, it is the intention of the City Council to lower the City's general fund operating levy as follows:
  - a. The City will reduce its December 2014 general operating millage levy by 0.3455 mills.
  - b. In future years, the City will reduce its general operating millage levy by 0.691 mills from the level that the City would otherwise have imposed.
