South Depot Park Bridge

Work is continuing nicely on the completion of the work around the new bridge. A group of volunteers spent the morning planting native plants, which were donated by Trish Henning, owner of American Roots. Ottman Advanced Asphalt completed the new path. The scope of the project was larger than anticipated. Ottman's donated a large amount of the overage. They went above and beyond because a lot of the work had to be done by hand, which increased the time and cost of labor. This has become truly a community wide project. Bart and Diane certainly planted a seed that has already multiplied.
