Election Day: Tuesday, November 7th

Tuesday, November 7th will be Election Day in the City, with residents voting on three candidates (Gary Casey, Laura Rodgers and Ted Quisenberry) who are running for three open City Council seats. Voters are kindly asked to not bring other City business to the office on Election Day, allowing the staff to focus on their election responsibilities.

Please be aware that the recently vacated mayor's position will *not* be on this ballot; City Council will select an interim mayor in their November 13th meeting, who will serve until the November 2024 election when voters will select a mayor.

City Clerk Karen DeLorge will be in the office this Saturday (November 4th) from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM to assist residents with voter registration, absentee ballots, and any questions they may have.
